How To Register

Information about MusA 11xx (Elective Private Lessons)

1. The applied music fee is \$300 for 15 half-hour lessons with a graduate TA (the fee is automatically charged to your student account when you register for lessons).
2. You will receive 2 credits for elective private lessons.
3. You must receive permission from the music department in order to register for lessons (see instructions below).
4. Once registered, you will be eligible to purchase a practice room card (which will enable you to use the practice rooms at the School of Music). During fall and spring semesters, non-music majors have two options for practice room cards: the semester card, which costs \$100 and is for unlimited use of the practice rooms (except during peak hours), or the hourly card, which costs \$50 and is good for ten hours of practice room use. For more information and/or to purchase a card, please visit the Student Services Office in 100 Ferguson Hall with a copy of your current registration.
5. We will make every effort to honor requests for a specific instructor.

Instructions

1. Complete attached request form and submit to 100 Ferguson Hall (even if you have previously taken elective lessons here). The form must be completed in its entirety or it cannot be processed.
2. Once your form has been processed, you will be assigned an instructor and entered for permission to register (the School of Music uses student-specific permissions rather than permission numbers).
3. You will receive an e-mail with your registration information (instructor, section number, etc.). At that point, you may register for your lessons.
4. Your instructor will contact you and together you will arrange your lesson times.
